### For Faculty of Science, Computer Science, Commerce & Management

1. Students of UG I, II, III and V Semester will be promoted.
2. Students having ATKT in UG I, III and V semester will also be promoted.
3. The classes of UG III semester will be beginning from 16 August, 2021 in online mode.
4. Offline Examination will be conducted for UG VI semester as per the guidelines of the State Government/Affiliating University.
5. The theory examination of UG VI semester will be commencing from 4th August and the Timetable for the same is enclosed. The practical marks will be awarded on the basis of viva-voce and practical records.
6. Offline Examination will be conducted for PG IV semester as per the guidelines of the State Government/Affiliating University.
7. No re-evaluation is permitted in the results where the student has been promoted.
8. Student who is not able to appear in terminal semester examinations due to his/her suffering from COVID-19, can apply for special examination, which will be conducted in old conventional manner in the next cycle as and when applicable. Further, this will be considered as their first attempt.
9. In case of promotion, the students who are not satisfied with the marks can apply for special examinations which will be conducted in old conventional manner in the next cycle as and when applicable. Further, this will be considered as their first attempt.
10. The theory examination of UG IV semester will be conducted after the completion of VI semester examinations. The Timetable will be announced soon. The practical marks will be awarded on the basis of viva-voce and practical records.
11. The examination of PG I, II and III semesters will be conducted after the completion of IV semester examinations.
12. Duration of offline terminal semester theory examination for UG & PG courses will be of 1.5hrs. For BSc, first & second paper of the particular subject will be conducted in same session of 3 hrs (1.5hrs x2). For Mathematics the third paper will be conducted on the separate day in a session of 1.5hrs, as per the guidelines of the affiliating University.
13. **ESE Paper Pattern for offline Examination of UG & PG courses:** There will be two sections in question papers namely section A & B.

**Section A** shall have 10 questions (two questions from each unit) of 2 marks each.

(Any four questions irrespective of units are to be attempted, answer limit 30 words)

**Section B** shall have 10 questions (two questions from each unit) of 8 marks each.

(Any four questions irrespective of units are to be attempted, answer limit 200 words).

The ESE will be of 40 Marks which will be converted out of 80/70 as the case may be.

## For Faculty of Pharmacy

### 1. For D. Pharm / B.Pharm./M.Pharm

As per State Government order all the Pharmacy Examination in offline mode shall be of 1 hr 30 min duration and pattern of Question Paper for different pharmacy courses shall be as follows:-

- D.Pharm Part I and Part II:** Students are required to attempt any three questions from seven questions of 16 marks each. Marks obtained out of 48 shall be converted into marks out of 80.
- B.Pharm Sem. I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII and VIII (New Scheme):** Question paper scheme shall be as follows:

**Section A (10 Marks):** 10 MCQ out of 20 MCQ of 1 mark each OR 05 Objective questions out of 10 questions of 2 mark each (various types)

**Section B (10 Marks):** Students are required to attempt any one question from three questions of 10 marks each.

**Section C (20 Marks):** Students are required to attempt any four questions from nine questions of 05 marks each.

Total Marks obtained out of 40 shall be converted into marks out of 75.

- B.Pharm Sem. I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII and VIII (Old Scheme):** Question paper scheme shall be as follows: Students are required to attempt any three questions from seven questions of 16 marks each. Marks obtained out of 48 shall be converted into marks out of 80.
- M.Pharm Sem I and II:** Students are required to attempt any three questions from seven questions of 15 marks each. Marks obtained out of 45 shall be converted into marks out of 75.
- Practical Examination of all courses of Pharmacy shall be held as per PCI / State Government / Affiliating University.
- Examination of B Pharm I, III, V, VII semester, D Pharm I year, M Pharm I semester will be held after completion of terminal semester/year examination
